

ST JOSEPH'S SCHOOL SCHOOL UNIFORM PROCEDURE

A school uniform promotes a sense of pride, responsibility and identity within the school and our wider community. All students are expected to wear the prescribed school uniform.

PURPOSES

1. To provide all students with standards of appropriate, practical and economical school clothing.
2. Encourage school pride and sense of identity.
3. To encourage sun sense.

GUIDELINES

1. The prescribed school uniform is to be worn as outlined in the School Uniform Schedule (*Appendix A*)
2. Parents/caregivers are responsible for ensuring that their child/ren are provided with, and wear the prescribed school uniform.
3. A note must should be provided if students are not in uniform. Acceptable alternative dress must be worn in these cases.
4. The staff of St Joseph's School will monitor the wearing of the prescribed school uniform.
5. Ultimately the Board of Trustees are responsible for the implementation of the School Uniform procedure.
6. In situations of non-compliance the procedures outlined in Appendix B will be followed.

CONCLUSION

This procedure introduces the school code of dress for St Joseph's School pupils.

GIRLS WINTER

School Tunic
White Blouse - long sleeve
Optional White Skivvy
Maroon jersey with monogram
White ankle socks or
Navy blue tights
Brown or black shoes
(Navy track pants are not to be worn under tunics at school)

GIRLS SUMMER

School Tunic
White Blouse - short sleeve
Maroon jersey with monogram
White ankle socks or no socks with sandals
Brown or black shoes

BOYS WINTER

Grey shirt - long sleeve
Optional grey skivvy
Optional blue tracksuit trouser (second and third term only)
Grey shorts
Maroon jersey with monogram
Grey socks with maroon and blue bands
Brown or black shoes

BOYS SUMMER

Grey polo shirt - short sleeve
Grey shorts
Maroon jersey with monogram
Grey socks with maroon and blue bands or no socks with sandals
Brown or black shoes

School Jersey may be hand knitted
Wool - Glenmist, Shade Burgundy 3940

The present uniform is available from Camerons, Marklins and Postie Plus.

School Tunics can be ordered through the School Community Group. All sizes are \$85.00. An order will be placed each term. Please contact Maree Lowen ☎684-7762 to make orders.

The School Community Group organise a second hand uniform service. School monograms for hand knitted jerseys can be obtained through the Group.

PHYSED AND SPORTS UNIFORM

Powder blue polo shirt with St Joseph's monogram (available through School Community Group)
Navy blue shorts (available through School Community Group)
White socks (when representing the school)
Sneakers

Sneakers are only for sports activities and are not to be worn as part of the uniform. Uniforms are provided by the school for team winter sports for classes Year 5 -8)

On sports days the Physed and Sport Uniform is required by all students, unless a supervisory teacher requests other more appropriate clothing - e.g. rugby jerseys, netball skirts.

CYCLE HELMETS

These are to be worn when cycling to and from school, and within school hours to sport or cultural events.

JEWELLERY

The only jewellery accepted at school will be:

Medical alert bracelets
Watches
Ear studs

MAKE UP AND NAIL POLISH

Make up, nail polish and coloured zinc are not permitted.

SUNHATS

Sunhats and sunscreen are strongly recommended for the summer months.

NON COMPLIANCE WITH UNIFORM PROCEDURE
APPENDIX B

These steps will apply when the School Uniform procedure is not followed –

1. The class teacher makes the initial inquiry as to why the uniform is not being worn. The answer may clarify the issue.
2. If the answer is unsatisfactory or the student does not wear the uniform as outlined in the procedure, a standard reminder note will be sent home by the class teacher.
3. If the matter is still unresolved, the Principal will personally contact the parents/caregivers to clarify the issue.
4. If non-compliance with the School Uniform procedure continues, an official letter will be mailed to the parents/caregivers formally outlining the Board's procedure.
5. Parents/caregivers may be asked to meet with the Board to resolve the issue.
